

<u>Superheroes</u>	
<i>Subject/ area</i>	<i>Subject Summary</i>
<i>English/ Literacy</i>	<p>This half term, Year 1 have enjoyed getting into the role of a superhero! They have learned and put actions to a superhero story, before completing some short burst writing. Finally, the children created their own version of the story.</p> <p>Whilst home learning, the children enjoyed creating their very own superhero! They then created a comic strip and their own story, featuring their superhero!</p>
<i>PSHE/SMSC/RRSA</i>	<p>This half term's focus was relationships. The children have talked about their families and have learned that there are lots of different types of families. They have looked at friendships and their own qualities as a person and a friend.</p>
<i>Maths</i>	<p>In maths this half term, the children have worked on key skills in addition and subtraction and also multiplication and division.</p> <p>During home learning, the children began to look at length and height and had fun comparing things that are taller and shorter than them.</p> <p>Year 1 have also began looking at fractions and so far, have enjoyed cutting and colouring shapes in half and quarters.</p>
<i>RE</i>	<p>Year 1 have enjoyed learning about the peaceful Buddha this half term! They have practised their meditation pose and have listened to lots of stories from the Buddhism religion.</p>
<i>Art</i>	<p>In art this half term, the children have enjoyed making sketches of their favourite superheroes. They have also all worked together on a collaborative pop art style poster.</p>

<i>History</i>	<p>In history this half term, the children have loved looking at our local history in and around Horden. The focus was life in the 1950s and 1960s, around the coal mining areas in Durham. The children enjoyed learning about Norman Cornish and his achievements throughout his life as a coal miner and artist.</p>

<i>Music</i>	<p>The children have loved learning the song A Whole New World which features in the Disney film 'Aladdin'. They have played instruments alongside the music and also sang and performed actions.</p>

<p><i>Computing</i></p>	<p>In computing, the children have used Google searches to look for their favourite superheroes. They thoroughly enjoyed taking photos of each other doing superhero poses, and have used Doodle to draw superhero essentials like capes and masks on their photos. The children have also used Google to research real-life heroes, such as the RNLI and Mountain Rescue.</p>
<p><i>MFL</i></p>	<p>In Spanish this half term the children have practised the vowel sound 'e'. They have developed their Spanish vocabulary through games and songs. They have also started to learn the colours in Spanish.</p>
<p><i>Science</i></p>	<p>Science this half term has been all about animals. The children started by investigating our school grounds, to see if they could find any traces of animals. They then learned about the different ways we can group animals, including by their appearance and their diet.</p>
<p><i>PE</i></p>	<p>In PE, the children have enjoyed OAA, which has developed their map skills and communication.</p> <p>They have also enjoyed learning different throwing techniques, using beanbags. They have developed defending skills, and put these to the test when playing games such as 10-point hoops.</p>
