Uniform

Thank you for the donations of uniform. Staff have ensured all items are of good quality (some are new with labels still attached), they have been washed and sorted by size. **We will make this available at the end of each day so please take what you need.**

Uniform consists of:

- white or red shirt / blouse / polo shirt,
- red cardigan / jumper,
- grey or black skirt / pinafore dress / trousers (not jogging bottoms)
- black shoes

Items which may be worn in Summer

- red / white gingham dress
- grey or black shorts

P.E. kit consists of:

- white t-shirt,
- black shorts and
- trainers or sandshoes
- jogging bottoms may be worn for outdoor PE.

You do not have to buy uniform with the school logo on it and parents are strongly advised to **write their child's name on all clothes labels** so that lost items can be returned.

Jewellery reminder - earrings, bracelets and necklaces should NOT be worn in school. If your child is unable to remove earrings due to recent piercings they will need to be covered.
